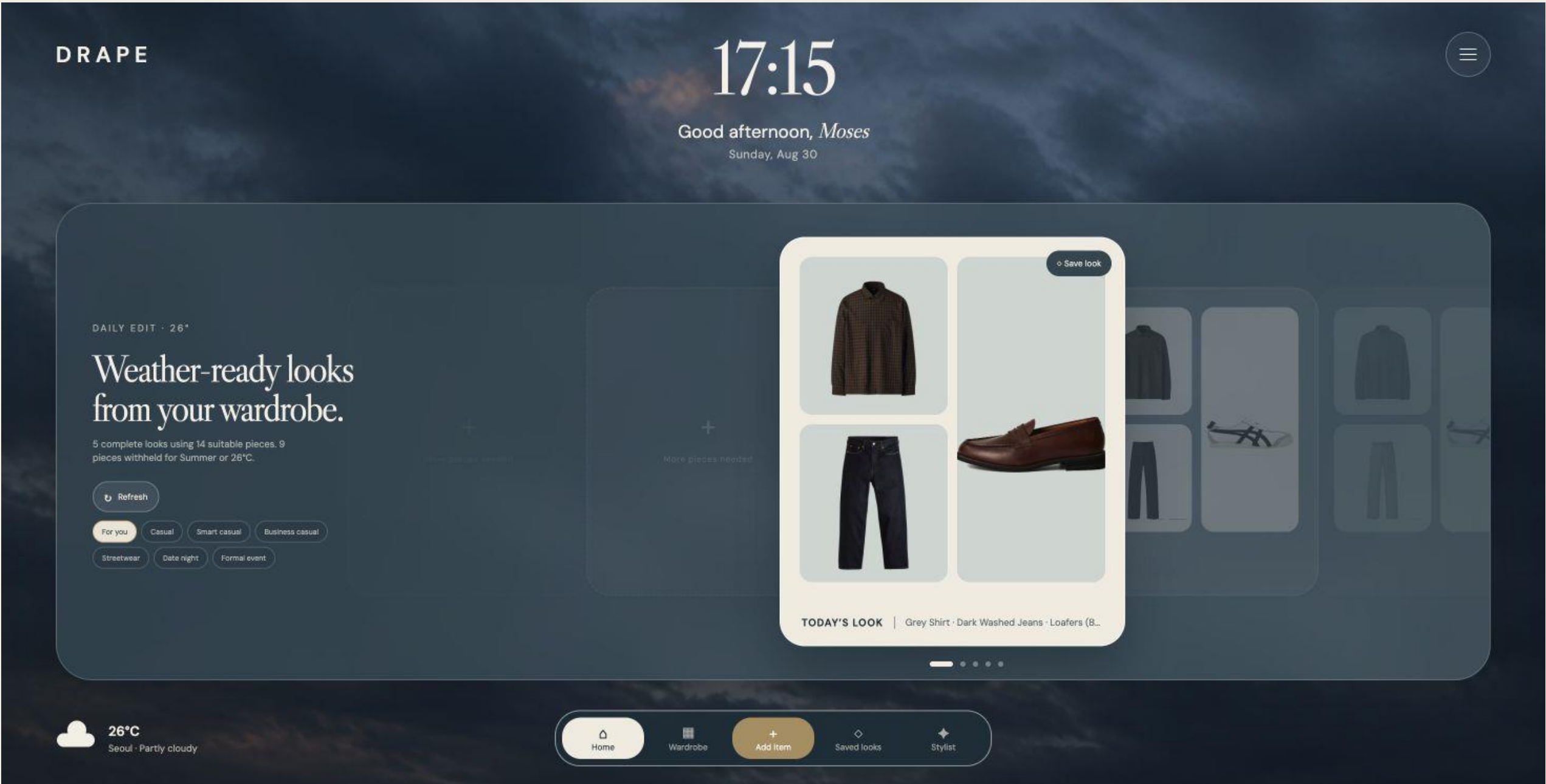

A daily edit, ready when you are.



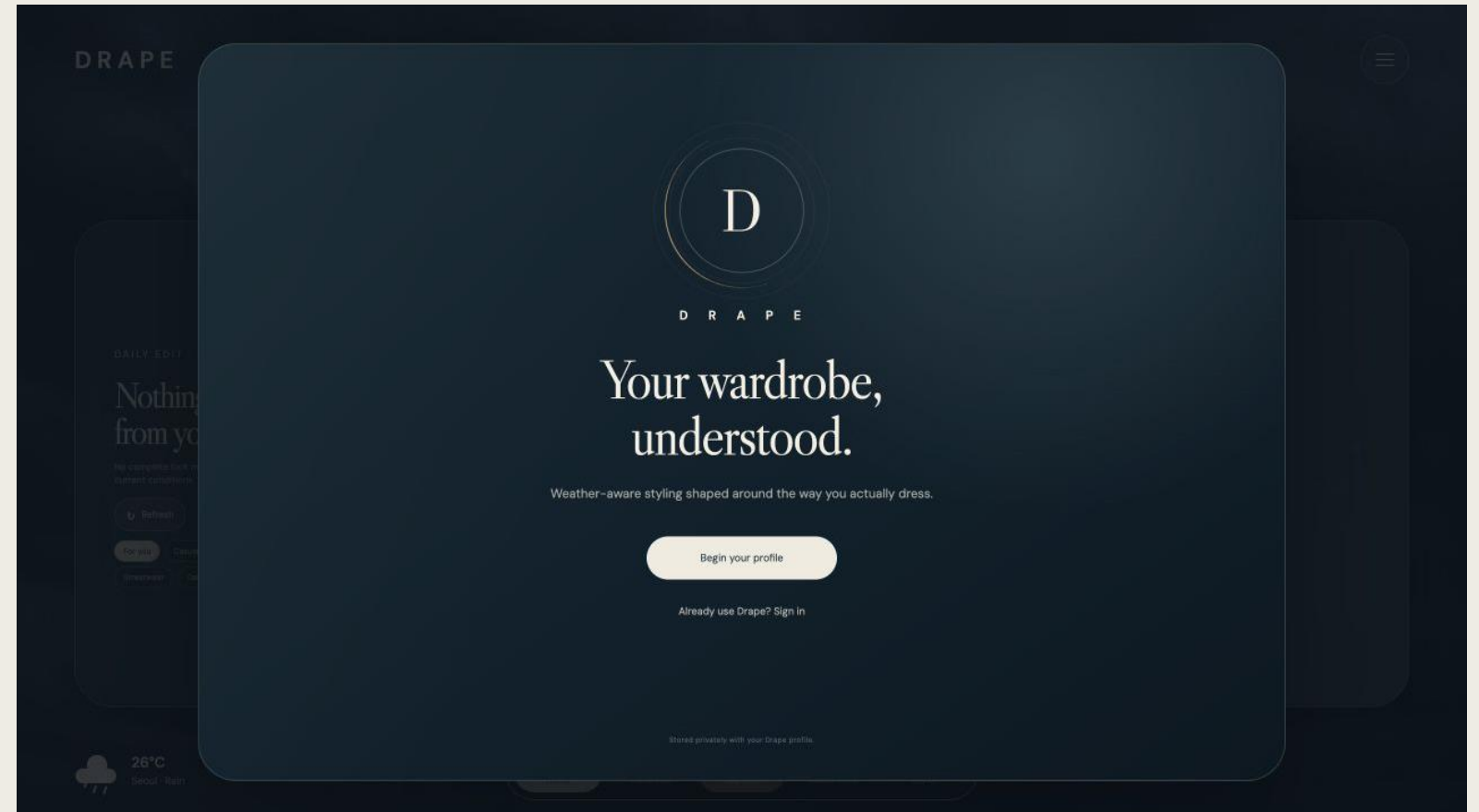
Start with the person, not the catalogue.

An intentional first launch

Animated Drape identity, followed by a guided personal profile.

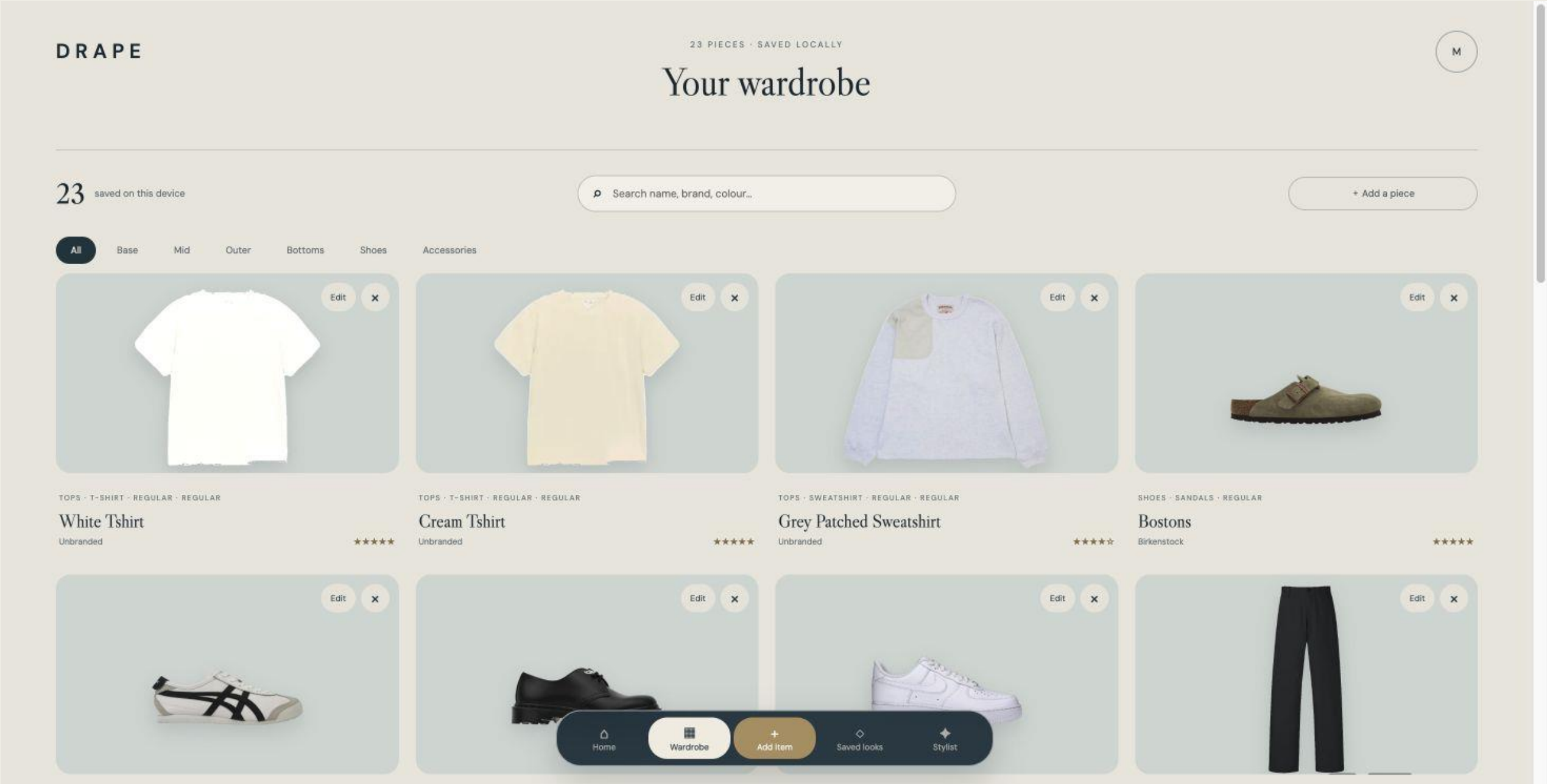
Preferences that stay editable

Name, age, sex, height and weight; metric or imperial; body type, silhouette, styles and temperature sensitivity.



Returning launch animation uses a one-hour cooldown.

Every piece, visible and findable.



A photograph becomes a wardrobe record.

- 01** Capture or choose

Use the camera or select a product image from the photo library.
- 02** Prepare the image

Create a transparent cutout while retaining a separate original.
- 03** Review the suggestions

Apple apps suggest garment type; all devices analyse colours. Review and correct the details.
- 04** Save and organise

Add seasons, occasions, fit and a personal rating, then save the piece.

Useful details—not just a name and photo.

Identity & organisation

- Name and brand
- Category and subtype
- Base, mid or outer layer

Wearability

- Multiple seasons and occasions
- Warmth and silhouette
- Presentation and item rating

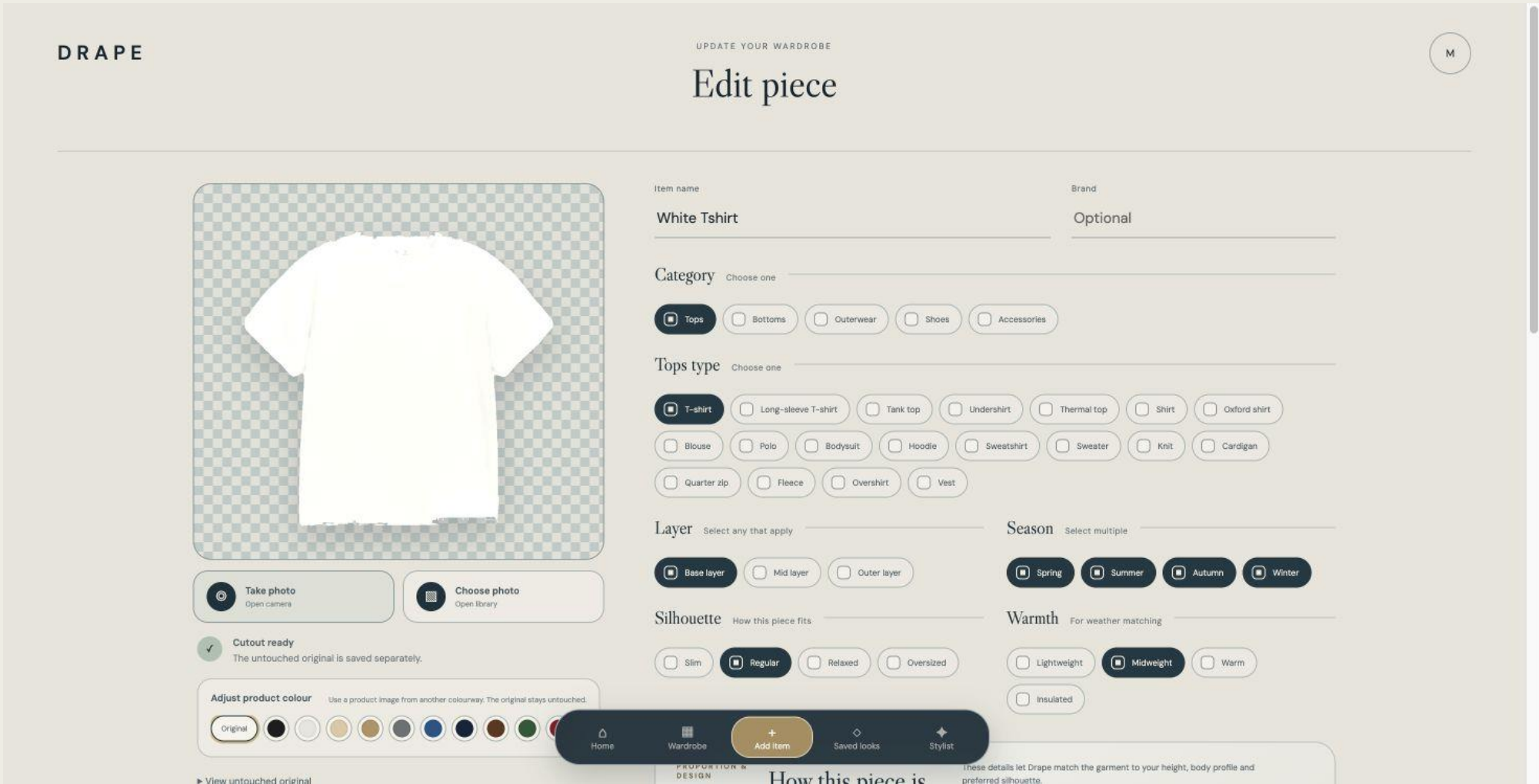
Colour & character

- Colour families
- Material and pattern
- Editable recognition suggestions

Garment proportions

- Length, structure and neckline
- Bottoms: waist rise and leg shape
- No garment-length fields for shoes

Keep the original. Refine the preview.



Cutout

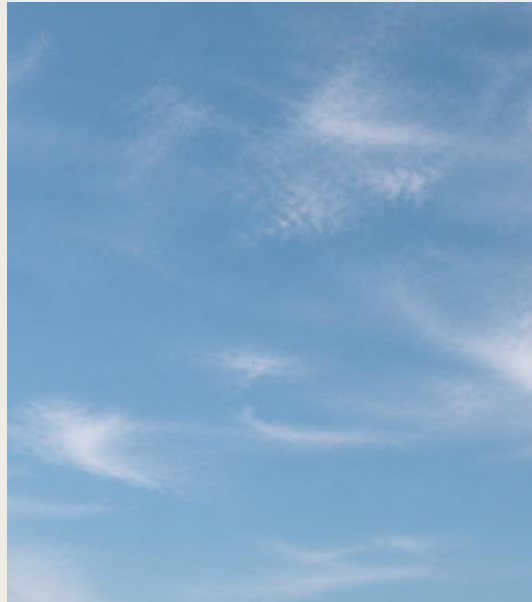
Automatic background removal for clean product photography.

Colour adjustment

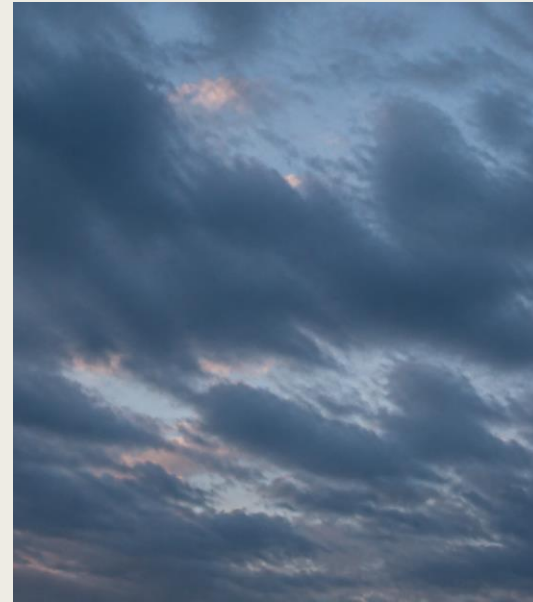
Approximate another colourway without replacing the original.

Current limit: white-on-white cutouts can fail; recolouring can also affect prints and trims.

The setting changes with the day.



Clear



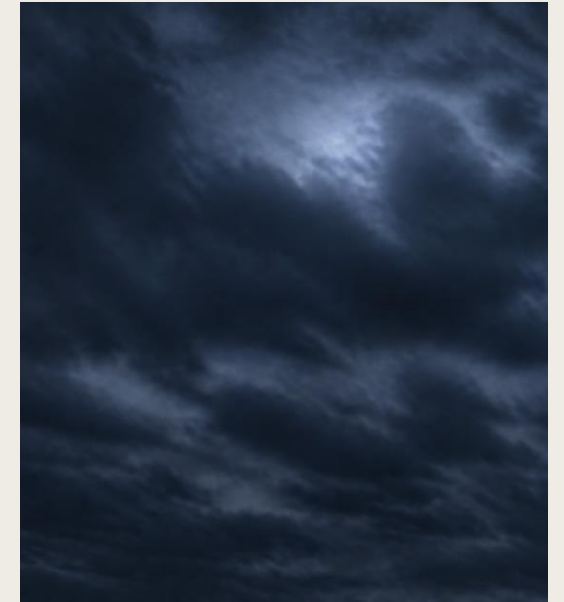
Cloudy

Dawn · Day · Dusk · Night

Current temperature, feels-like, rain and wind inform styling.

Sunrise and sunset inform the atmosphere; the device keeps the clock.

Only your clothes. Only suitable candidates.

- 01 Filter the wardrobe

Screen for season, temperature, rain and occasion before creating a look.
- 02 Rank combinations

Balance colour, pattern, formality, silhouette, proportion, warmth and preferences.
- 03 Offer a focused edit

Show up to five combinations, with refresh and occasion controls.

No invented clothing when the wardrobe is incomplete.

Build warmth without losing structure.

Base

T-shirts, shirts and other next-to-body pieces.

Mid

Hoodies, sweaters, knits and insulating layers.

Outer

Coats, puffers and jackets for protection outside.

Pair with bottoms and footwear.

The engine evaluates one-, two- and three-layer combinations. The manual builder also includes an accessory slot.

Understand the outfit before wearing it.

A closer look

Expand a recommendation to review its components and styling explanation.

Why it works

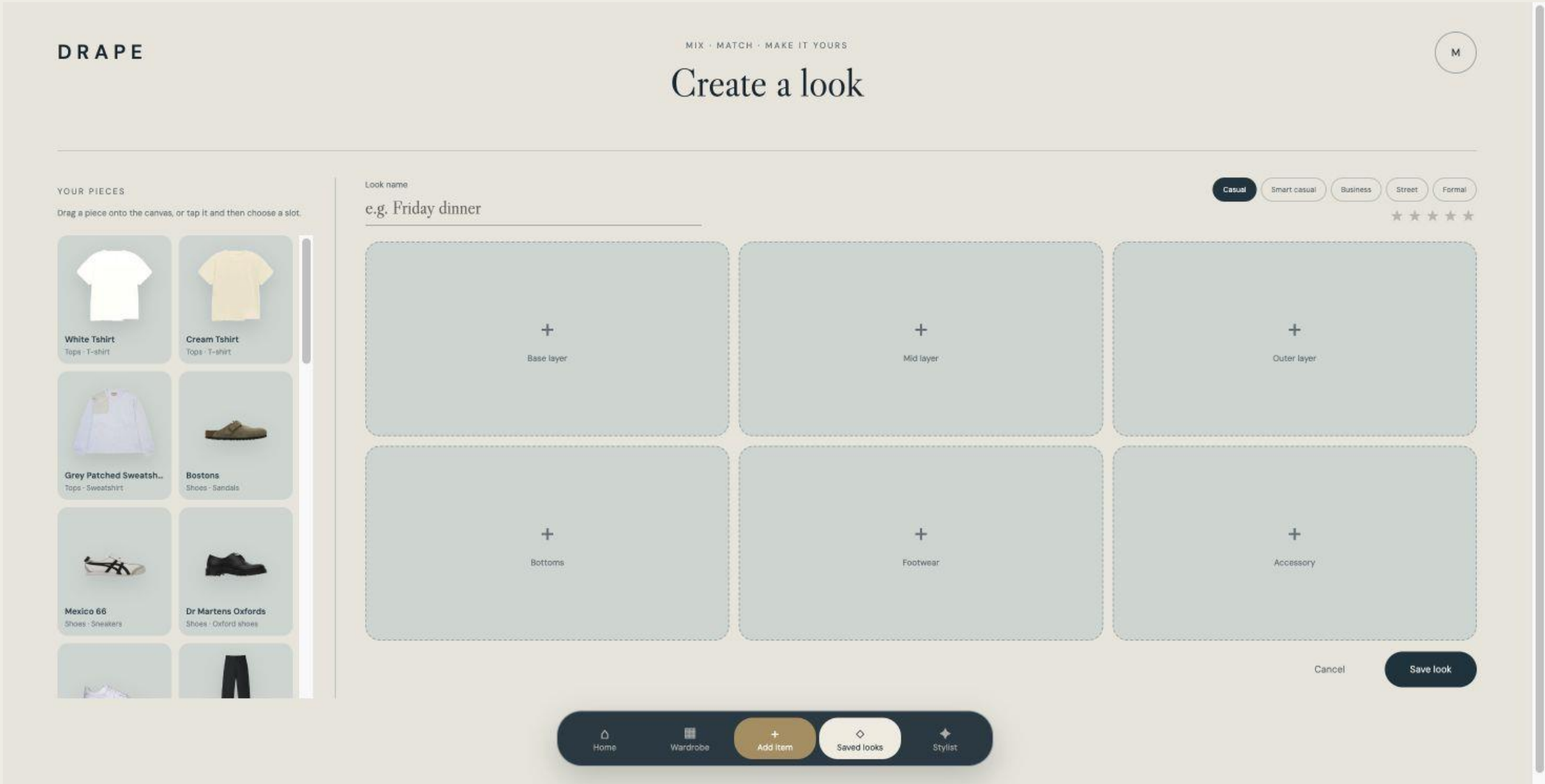
Short guidance on the combination, how to wear it and where it fits.

Keep it—or reject it

Save the look or mark it “Not for me.” Exact rejected combinations are withheld.

Today: rule-based explanations. Future: richer visual reasoning and broader preference learning.

Your judgement stays in the loop.



Mix & match

Drag a piece to a slot, or tap to select and place it.

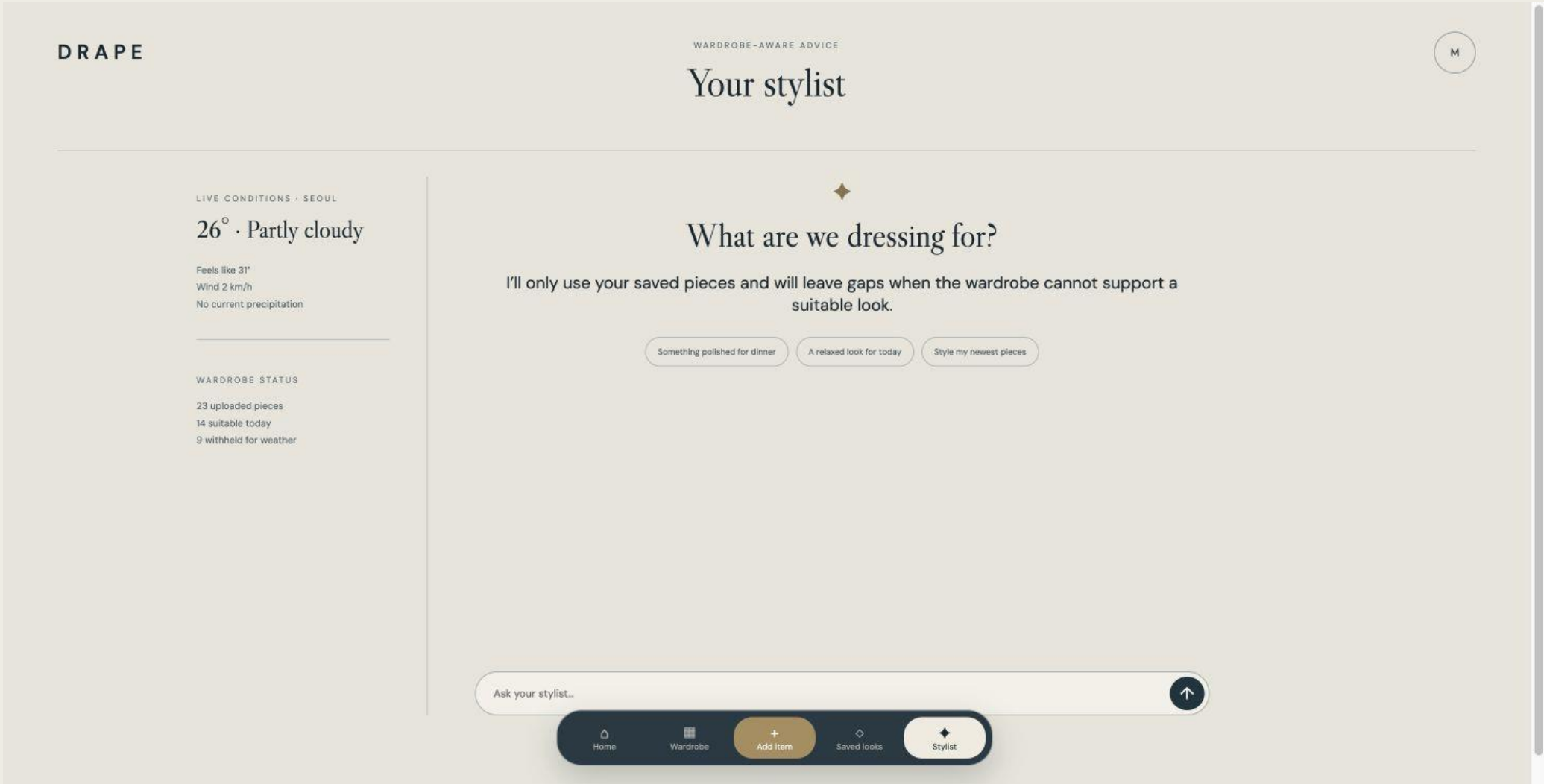
Name the look, select its occasion and add a rating.

Turn good combinations into a personal archive.

| 01 | Save | Keep a daily suggestion, stylist result or manually created outfit. |
| 02 | Edit | Change its name, occasion or components; delete looks you no longer want. |
| 03 | Rate | Give a look one to five stars and keep favourites near the top. |

Item ratings affect curation now. Learning from outfit ratings is the next step.

Ask for a look built around your pieces.



A focused request

Ask for a garment, an occasion or an indoor outfit.

Honest boundaries

Uses rules and keywords—not a general conversational AI.

One wardrobe for three daily contexts.

iPad

A landscape-first dressing station.
A calm daily edit on a stand.

iPhone

Capture and organise on the go.
Take your wardrobe with you.

Desktop

Review on a larger screen.
Upload product photos while
browsing.

Sign in with the same Drape account.

Items, images, saved looks and profiles sync through Supabase.
Styling runs locally without a ChatGPT login.
Fresh weather and cross-device syncing need a connection.

A working personal-use beta—not just a mockup.

Wardrobe & looks

Create, edit, delete, search, filter and rate

Daily styling

Weather eligibility, layered ranking and detail views

Image tools

Cutouts, colour analysis and preview recolouring

Device experience

Installed Apple app plus hosted desktop website

Data continuity

Account-based sync with local persistence

12 styling tests passed in the source review. Broader device and reliability testing remains.

Move from useful rules to deeper understanding.

Better garment vision

Garment-aware segmentation, repair tools, exact-product lookup and richer print analysis.

A stylist that learns

Use outfit ratings and explained feedback to learn colour, silhouette and styling preferences.

Less work to add clothes

Product-page image import and purchase-import connections where feasible.

A broader wardrobe

One-piece outfits, smarter accessories and more diverse personal styles.

Prove reliability before expanding the promise.

| 01 | Protect the wardrobe | Test interrupted uploads, offline edits, sync conflicts, deletion and recovery. |
| 02 | Evaluate real outfits | Use a varied wardrobe and user-rated examples to improve ranking and diversity. |
| 03 | Close platform gaps | Improve desktop recognition and keep installed apps aligned with web releases. |
| 04 | Prepare for other users | Account recovery, deletion, accessibility, privacy review and repeatable releases. |
